<p><b>Subject: Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting</b></p> <p><b>Present: Councillors</b> – Michael Allmey, Michael Harvey Tony Jolly, &amp; David Jenvey  <b>Absentees</b> – Sarah Young, Lee Smith &amp; Guy Mathias sent their apologies  <b>Residents</b> – None</p> <p><b>Declaration of interest</b> – none</p> <p><b>Minutes of previous meeting</b> – these await signature at next scheduled meeting.</p> <p><b>This meeting was convened to address two urgent matters that could not wait for the next scheduled meeting on February 10<sup>th</sup> 2017.</b></p> <p><b>1. Planning application Ref: 5020/16 - Holly Tree House</b>  This application was recommended with the caveat that the new outbuilding should not be used for human habitation without further planning approval.  This recommendation was proposed by MH and seconded by MA</p> <p><b>2 Scrub clearance on the Green</b>  The PC had received a Suffolk Wildlife Trust recommendation of how this should be done. It necessitated work to be completed by mid-February to avoid disturbing nesting birds. [Ref: SWT email dated 11<sup>th</sup> January 2017].  The cost of this work would be c.£700 (plus VAT), significantly less than £2,000 (plus VAT) originally quoted by the chosen contractor, Mr George Hunt.
