Proposed by MA and seconded by LS</p> <p>MSDC Report: 1, Council is considering retracting planning permission when sites have not been developed 2. National government demands for new housing is putting pressure on local government to be more positive in granting planning permission 3. Recent enquiries about social misbehaviour were a police responsibility not the housing department</p> <p>Agenda items: 1. Wingfield Green: The new trees have been delivered and will be planted in locations agreed with grazing rights holders. Waveney Tree Surgeons have a backlog of work after the recent storms but will attend the problems with the horsechestnuts bordering the Castle Moat asap. 2. VAS Speeding Signage: It was suggested that the MSDC funding could be topped up with similar from Suffolk County Council The “smiley face” configuration suggested drains the batteries and therefore rejected 3. Post Box (removed from Vicarage Road): This should now be taken up with more senior Royal Mail management 4. Village road surfaces and road signs: A slide show of all defects found in the village was presented. It was agreed that it be sent to Suffolk Highways with notification of drainage problems 5.
