| <p>Extraordinary Parish Meeting</p> <p>Attendance: Parish Councillors: Lee Smith: Michael Harvey; Tony Jolley & Melanie Murray Apologies; Mike Allmey & Guy Mathias Residence: 6 Declarations of interest: None</p> <p>This meeting was primarily called to discuss a planning application (DC/17/05903) previously recommended by the PC but subsequently challenged by residents neighbouring the development. Both parties attended the meeting.</p> <p>The meeting concluded that the Parish Council's original recommendation would stand but conditions, agreed by both parties, should apply.</p> <p>Namely:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• HGV deliveries/despach would be restricted to the western side of the greenhouse.• Cars and light vans would be able to use the site as they currently do.• Green house working hours would be limited to 6.00 to 22.00 hours with allowance for exceptional circumstances.• In these circumstances, the Nursery should obviate any potential disturbance caused.• Screening between the greenhouse and the neighbouring property (Bancroft) should be erected within the next two years. <p>Other Matters</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It was agreed that the two impending vacancies on the Parish Council should be filled by co-option. An election is due in 2019 and the Council should avoid the expense of two elections in two years. All candidates should be informed of this decision by letter.• The recent tree surgery on the Green should be cleared.
