The location for it had to be changed because of the potential closure of the De La Pole. The alternative suggestion of the telephone box was agreed but the reconnection to the electicity had to be investigated Planning: Three applplications (DC/19/3890; 3889 & 04158) for "agricultural determination" were approved. Wingfield Green: The "topping" of the Green had been completed but upset two residents complaining of damage to wildlife and barn owls in particular. The PC stated that they had followed advice from Suffolk Wildlife Trust but promised to review its plans for next year.
