

Report from Wingfield Parish Council

Our last meeting took place on January 25th and primarily focussed on planning for the year ahead.

The following measures need to be endorsed by the new Council to be elected on May 2nd at the District and Parish elections (See noticeboard and website for details)

1. **Wingfield Green.** Completion of “topping” the northside and inviting interested parties to graze the Green with sheep.
2. **Churchyard.** Installation of new bench and cutting back vegetation from perimeter wall.
3. **Telephone box.** Using the box as a memorial to the Village School and its last headmistress.
4. **Castle Crescent Green.** To facilitate improvements suggested by residents in partnership with MSDC, the ultimate authority regarding the land in question.
5. **Defibrillator.** The Council agreed that this should be purchased and installed at the De La Pole Arms with permission of the landlords.

Finally, the Council would like to draw all resident’s attention to the footpaths in the village available for walking and exercising dogs. A map will be posted on the noticeboard and website.

The field margin, belonging to Castle Farm, running behind the properties on Castle Crescent and Vicarage Rad is not a footpath and should not be trespassed.

The next meeting of Wingfield Parish Council will take place on May 17th, 2019 and will also serve as the Annual Parish Meeting.
